### The winners of the 2020 Swiss Innovation Challenge



### AgroSustain SA – the 2020 Swiss Innovation Challenge winning project

Food rotting in the field or further along the supply chain to the consumer is too common a sight. The UNO organisation FAO (Food and Agriculture Organisation) estimates that around one third of the world's food production, worth 1.66 trillion US dollars, is wasted. AgroSustain aims to reduce food waste and promote sustainable agriculture by developing natural means of crop protection using environmentally friendly organic solutions from the field to the fork.



### Resistell AG – the 2020 Swiss Innovation Challenge runner-up

Resistell proposes an alternative to the culture-based antibiogram, the current gold standard for antibiotic susceptibility testing. Resistell offers a diagnostic device based on the rapid AST method for detecting movement caused by live bacterial cells. Because the test is growth-independent, the time it takes to get a result is reduced from days to minutes. Resistell provides information on which antibiotic should be used to treat the patient and in which concentration it should be administered.

### help2type GmbH – third place in the 2020 Swiss Innovation Challenge

A haptic keyboard for smartphones

Starting position! Close your eyes for a moment and try to type a message on your smartphone. It takes forever. This is how 300,000 blind and visually impaired people in Switzerland feel today. Solution: a compact keyboard that can be attached directly to the smartphone. The attachment makes it possible to flip the keyboard from the screen to the back of the smartphone. The keyboard is connected via Bluetooth. It works with IOS and Android. Mission: we believe in helping you connect better in the digital world thanks to help2type.
