

The Basel Area is the most affordable metropolitan area in Switzerland and stands out with the lowest corporate income tax of all major Swiss business centers. The cost of office space in the Basel Area is significantly lower than in Zurich or Geneva. Social contribution costs are levied on the federal level and are much lower than in most other European countries. These factors make Switzerland and in particular the Basel Area one of the most productive locations worldwide – and in the life sciences industry, the Basel Area has Switzerland's highest productivity.

Pocket-size metropolis, perfectly connected

Centrally located in the heart of Europe, the Basel Area is Switzerland's most accessible location (UBS Cantonal Competitiveness Indicator). Bordering Germany and France, two of the largest European markets are right on your doorstep to quickly and efficiently expand business. Multiple daily direct flights and high-speed train connections from Basel to all major European destinations move people and goods easily. Within the region, attractive premises for laboratories, offices and production sites can be found within very short distances. You can bike to work or your next event or even walk from one meeting on one end of town, to one in another part of the city.

- International EuroAirport Basel Mulhouse Freiburg: 15 minutes from the city center
- Rail and road: direct train connection to Paris as well as to many other main cities, and easy transcontinental transport of goods
- Rhine ports: direct access to Rotterdam, Antwerp and the sea
